How to reach us:

L'Aquila is within easy reach of Rome by bus.

The buses "Autolinee TUA" and "Flixbus" leaves from Tiburtina Station:

- Trains to Tiburtina Station depart every 20 minutes (from 6.15 a.m to 12.15 p.m.) from "Leonardo da Vinci" Airport (Fiumicino). The journey takes about 40 minutes.
- Buses depart from "Ciampino" Airport every 15-20 minutes for the the Anagnina underground station, where you can take an underground

train ("metropolitana") to Termini station. When you reach Termini station, you will have to change from the A to the B line for Tiburtina. The journey takes about an hour.

- You can purchase a bus ticket for L'Aquila online or from the ticket offices near the Tiburtina bus station. The journey takes 1 hour and 40 minutes and the bus terminates at **Collemaggio terminal**.

The bus "Gaspari" leaves directly from "Leonardo da Vinci" Airport
(Fiumicino) and Ciampino Airport and terminates at
Amiternum Hotel.
