APPLICATION FOR SIICA TRAVEL GRANTS For young members only

To support the participation of **young SIICA members** to SIICA 6th International Congress on Translational Immunology, SIICA will release **travel grants** supported by Associazione Italiana per la Ricerca sul Cancro (AIRC) and European Federation of Immunological Societies (EFIS). Grants are intended to cover the travel expenses and/or the registration fee and will be assigned based on the quality of the submitted abstract to the meeting, as well as on the CV of the applicant. Young SIICA members are eligible to receive a travel grant according to the following requirements:

- Being under 35 years of age. 18 months extension per child applies to mothers and fathers. Documented maternity/paternity leave should be provided.
- For Italians, being a SIICA member; for non-Italians, being a member of an EFIS affiliated European Immunology Society, in regular position with membership fees.
- Not holding a permanent job position
- Being the presenter of the abstract

The following travel grants will be provided:

- **Up to € 300,00 for Italian Participants**
- **Up to € 500,00 for European Participants**

The application must be sent by e-mail to siica.amministrazione@siica.it with subject heading **“Application to SIICA - Travel Grants – NAME OF CANDIDATE”** by **2nd April 2024**. Candidates must provide the following information in the body of the email:

- the number of the submitted and accepted abstract
- date of Birth
- place of job
- declaration of not holding a permanent job position
- SIICA membership or other EFIS affiliated European Immunology Society fee paid (until 2023)
- h-index
- cumulative impact factor
- total number of peer-reviewed publications as first, last or corresponding author

For delegate participating to both Ph.D. Retreat in Otranto and the International Conference in Monopoli, Otranto early deadline fee will apply until March 16, 2024

Names of grant winners will be posted on the congress website. Grant holders will be asked to fill out a travel expense claim form and attach the original receipts to get the reimbursement.
